<p>Ulster University BSc Hons Nursing (Adult) BSc Hons Nursing (Mental Health)</p>	<p>Entry Requirements 2 distinctions and 6 merits</p> <p>Applicants will also need to have English, Maths and Science at Grade H6 (Higher Level) or Grade O4 or above (Ordinary Level) if not sitting at Higher Level as part of their Irish Leaving Certificate.</p> <p>They will consider those who have gained a distinction in the communication unit as satisfying the English requirements, and those achieving a distinction in the Anatomy and Physiology unit as satisfying the science requirements. Maths however needs to be taken at Irish Leaving.</p>
<p>University of Birmingham BSc Nursing (Adult) BSc Nursing (Mental Health) BSc Nursing (Child)</p>	<p>Successful applicants need to achieve Distinctions in at least five components including Anatomy and Physiology, Introduction to Nursing and Human Growth and Development, Nursing theory and Practice or Biology.</p> <p>Please note however, that the School of Nursing will not consider applications from QQI students who completed the Irish Leaving Certificate within the last five years and wouldn't meet our entry requirements with that qualification (ILC Higher Level grades H2,H2,H2,H2) . Applicants who have taken the Irish Leaving Certificate would require 5 or more subjects including English, Maths and a science subject at either H3 or O3 grade</p> <p>All applicants have to satisfy the GCSE requirements of the Nursing courses although we do consider equivalent qualifications.</p>
